## Sweet dreams



Woven Dreams. A Story of Artisanal Headboards is the new collection of special edition designer headboards presented by Bolzan at the FuoriSalone in Milan. The protagonists are four international designers well known for their experimental approach to design that results in an original and distinctive creative vocabulary: India Mahdavi, Julie Richoz, Sam Baron and Martino Gamper (OBE).

Each designer has explored materials, forms and colors with their own stylistic code, each giving rise to a work, numbered and signed, that amplifies the concept of the headboard: a functional element of the bed, but also a versatile component with an outstanding expressive value. As in the case of Courtoisie by Sam Baron: an enveloping structure inspired by historic canopies, in wood and woven fabric, of sinuous grandeur. Architectural flair again for Fiocco by Martino Gamper, a wooden headboard that plays with the movement of the side wings and the graphic design of the grain. Backdrop, by the French-Swiss designer Julie Richoz, is a theatrical and floating textile backdrop in felt that asserts itself lightly in space. India Mahdavi, with the Rosary project, imagines the bed as a personal and customizable sanctuary. It is defined by a velvet panel surmounted by ceramic rings of different sizes and colors that can be combined as desired.

With the Woven Dreams collection, Bolzan introduces a new authorial vision of the headboard-as-object, presenting original contemporary visions of living in the bedroom and building a creative bridge between craft skills and innovation. **Katrin Cosseta / bolzan.com**
